Montpelier, VT – The Vermont Regional Center (VRC) will pursue [a motion for reopening and reconsideration](#) of the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) Administrative Appeals Office September 25, 2019 decision affirming the closure of the VRC.

The decision to seek a motion for reconsideration was made after consultation with the VRC's EB-5 counsel and the impacted VRC projects. The VRC filed the motion on October 25, 2019.

The state continues to advocate for an orderly wind-down of the VRC to best preserve the economic benefits while also protecting those immigrant investors whose immigration status remains unresolved.
